

Networking and Social Program

All lodging listed in the Call for Papers is close to the slopes. Many accommodations have spectacular views, a swimming pool, hot tub, sauna, fitness room, and ski-in ski-out facilities. There are hotel-type accommodations as well as deluxe 2, 3, and 4 bedroom condos with complete kitchens, balconies, fireplaces, washers, and dryers. Free shuttles run within the village. The Slopeside Huntley Lodge and the Shoshone Hotel are the most conveniently located, as they are in the same building as the conference center. The Huntley's price includes a gigantic breakfast buffet from 6:30-10:30 a.m.

Recreational activities in Big Sky include downhill skiing, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and dog-sledding. Horseback riding and winter fly-fishing are available at nearby Gallatin Canyon, and

snowmobiling in Yellowstone National Park is just an hour away. See last two pages for details and phone numbers.

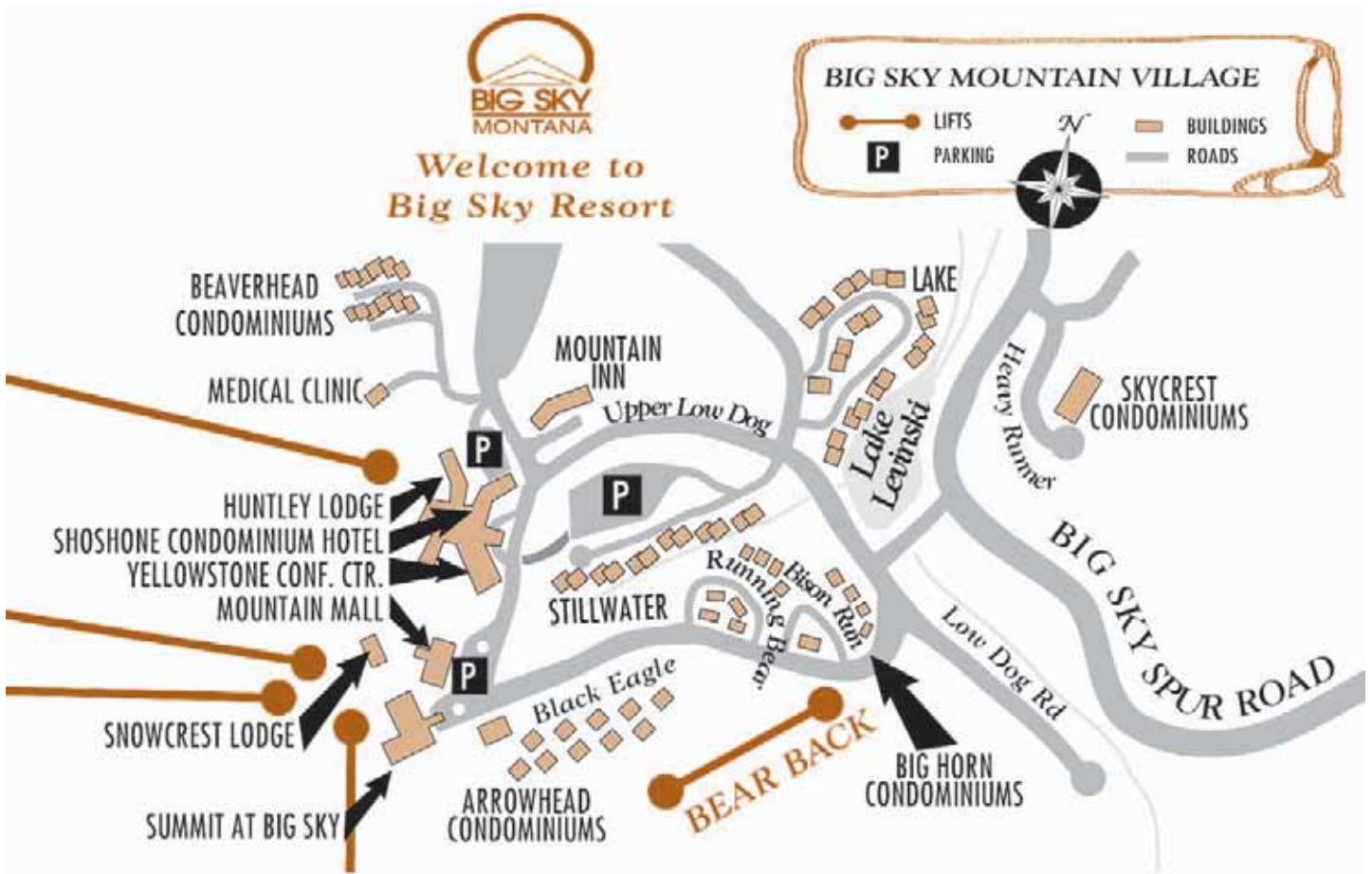
